Education, in a broad sense, is the core activity of the network: we have been creating a solid pan-European and global community by facilitating the internationalisation of the initiatives through sharing experiences and educational materials.

- Design online learning activities for URGENCI's education platform.
- Oversee our training and education methodology approach.
- Design learning curricula for various training programmes on a range of topics.
- Produce learning materials and support for these activities.
- Develop our uptake strategy for them.
- Facilitate trainings.
